Project Overview

In preparation for the construction site of the new overflow tunnel along the alignment of 88 Avenue, west of Mill Creek, the City of Edmonton's crew will conduct hydro excavation work from the surface down to expose and verify the location of buried utilities close to the site of the shaft that will be used for construction.

The work on this new overflow tunnel will involve constructing a 12 metre long (900 mm diameter, approximately 10 metres deep) tunnel, and an additional shaft (3 m wide) on the west side of the bicycle trail (*See attached image on the reverse side of this Notice*). A detailed schedule of the project timeline will be shared once it is finalized.

Traffic Accommodations

The bicycle trail around the work site will be closed to the public for approximately five hours.

Safety

Barricades will be used to isolate the work site.

Schedule

The hydro excavation work to expose and verify the location of existing buried utilities is scheduled for April 13th, 2017 and is expected to take about one day to complete.
